12.	Brief description of the activity	Awareness on Covid Appropriate Behaviour
		 Deep organised an awareness programme for educating children in street situation on COVID appropriate behaviour in CD Park, Jahangir Puri area on 11th February 2022 from 12 PM to 4 PM
		• Firstly, we tried to aware them about this infectious disease and how it can spread from person to person in lack of proper awareness and preventive care. We discussed about the importance of personal sanitation and social distancing in preventing the spread of infection with their active involvement in this discussion.
		 For further awareness we talked about the manners through which they can ensure

	their personal sanitation, health and hygiene. With their involvement we showed them the proper way of hand washing and hand sanitising. They were also briefed about the right manner of wearing a mask and the importance of using a clean mask.
	 Drawing Competition We also conducted a drawing competition. We wanted to make sure whether they properly understood all the activities of the awareness
	programme and should be able to remember all the necessary information in future as well, so we encouraged them to participate in a drawing competition on the theme of 'cleanliness and hygiene' . Children were encouraged to cooperate with each other and help each other out.
	• All the children were properly sanitised and masked prior to the activity. After the drawing competition free refreshments were distributed among all children.

	Children were highly interested and enthusiastic throughout the whole programme. They were actively listening, were actively involved in discussion and

		even expressed what they have learned in their own simplistic manner.
		 Throughout the various activities they properly cooperated with members of the organization and maintained proper discipline.
		• We asked them about their experience in this awareness programme and we felt so delighted to hear from them that they loved it and even showed interest to take part in such future activities. The children felt content, happy, heard and seen. We are very confident that it left a good impact on all the children because they kept inquiring us about when are we planning to conduct such activities and meet them again in near future.
